<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 2 years Advanced Placement English (Language and Literature) 2 additional English electives • ACT English score of 25 or higher or SAT English score of 620 or higher • Minimum cumulative GPA of 3.5 in English classes • Active participation in Logan High School Poetry Club • Participation in <i>Reflections</i> writing contest • Assemble a writing portfolio demonstrating writing progress through high school career • Debate: two or more years active participation as determined by coaches. • Outside scholarship or awards related to English • Additional options may be proposed to the LHS English department 	<i>Transcript, club advisor signature, description & teacher signature, etc.</i>
