Part E: Any two of the following:	
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Be an active participant or leader in a foreign language club at Logan High. 2. Carry on a correspondence in the foreign language with a pen pal for at least six months (minimum of three letters) 3. Receive a rating of excellent or better in an individual event at the foreign language fair. 4. Participate as a volunteer at a college language fair. 5. Travel in a country where the language is spoken and record your experiences with the language. 6. Score in the top 25% on a national language test. 7. Fulfill the Active Teacher's Aide requirements in a world language class and keep a journal of teaching activities. 8.
